



Tentative Schedule for National Finals

9:00 AM- Arrival - *Sunday, April 29 at Manhattan Day School. Address: 310 W 75th St, New York, NY 10023. There will be a place to store luggage.*

9:20 AM - 9:45 AM- Opening Ceremonies

9:45 AM - 12:30 - Two written Exams for Kids/Back to back Shiurim for Adults

Kids: Two written exams are taken over the course of this time period. There will be twenty minutes between exams.

Adults: There will be back to back shiurim given by Rabbi David Fohrman and Rav Moshe Shulman. Exact timing and topics TBD

12:30 - 1:45- Lunch/Chidon Activities

Lunch will only be available for participating National Finalists.

Chidon Carnival - The activities component is a newer addition to the National Finals. There will be trivia games set up around the room for kids to participate in, showcase their knowledge, and win tickets for raffles at the end of the competition.

1:45 - 2:15 - Chavruta Learning

Contestant will be paired up with fellow contestants from around the country to meet one another and learn with one another.

2:15 - 3:30 - Verbal Competition/Concluding Ceremony

Top contestants are called to the front for a verbal round. Audience and other contestants are still involved in this round as well. All contestants receive a commemorative Tanach and individualized certificate of accomplishment from the Chidon at the conclusion of the ceremony. The ceremony will conclude with the singing of Ha'Tikva. We recommend factoring a 3:15 end time into your plans, in case the day's events run a bit late.
